Volunteers will be coordinated by a skilled team leader each day. Just show up with a hammer, tape measure and closed toed shoes and they will quickly put you to work.

Volunteer work days are Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 8:00-5:00. You can offer your services in either 4 or 8 hour shifts beginning the week of October 18th. Our construction site is located near 623 River Street in Spring Lake on Branmar Court. The project is expected to last 11 weeks, so as you can imagine we need as many volunteers as possible. If you are unable to do work at the actual site, there are other ways to participate. The work crews always appreciate food, snacks & beverages. Each task is vital to the completion of the home.
